

Amazing Instant Challenge

This challenge works best with smaller teams (2-4 people) if you have a large team (5-7) you can consider breaking into two groups and see who achieves the most points. The decision to stay together or split up is to be made by the team.

Your team's challenge is to have one team member navigate a maze using a pen or pencil while having their eyes closed. The other team members can communicate to the team member solving the maze using non-verbal communication methods.

Your team will have up to 3 minutes to devise a communication method and plan using the practice maze and up to 3 minutes to solve the maze.

Rules:

- The communication method must be non-verbal, for the purposes of this challenge non-verbal means any spoken language commonly used by human beings.
- The communication method may not involve team members physically guiding the maze solver's hand, arm, writing instrument or paper
- During the first 3 minutes the team will be given a sample maze to practice with, when the second three minutes begin the team will be given a new maze, the maze solver is not allowed to view this maze until the challenge has ended

Scoring:

- 20 points for teamwork
- 20 points for the creativity of the communication method
- 60 points for solving the maze, points may be lost for solving the maze as follows
 - Loss of 10 points for touching and crossing over any maze line (maximum loss of 30 points)
 - Loss of 5 points for touching a line but staying or returning to the same side (maximum loss of 30 points)
