Wisconsin Destination Imagination, Inc. Approves New State Tournament Site

GERMANTOWN, Wisconsin — The Wisconsin Destination Imagination, Inc.'s (WIDI) board of directors approved a new hosting agreement for the Destination Imagination Wisconsin state tournament at their June 2018 meeting. Key changes include shifting the site from University of Wisconsin – Stevens Point (UWSP) to the University of Wisconsin – Green Bay (UWGB) and partnership with the University's Division of Continuing Education and Community Engagement beginning with the 2018-19 Destination Imagination season.

Preparations are already underway for 2018-19 state tournament, scheduled for Saturday, April 13, 2019. The UWGB campus offers enhanced off-street parking, campus dining, and activity options, to highlight a few. The Kress Events Center (KEC) offers the capacity to once again, unify the Closing Celebration for all teams and supporters to celebrate together. Partnering with the Division of Continuing Education and Community Engagement, WIDI also plans to offer special rates via discount codes with area hotels for teams staying overnight.
